Financial Assistance Opportunities

The Ben Ketterhagen Memorial Scholarship — Awarded to a junior who embraces the opportunity to help others through organ donation. Funds awarded are applied towards tuition. (\$300 value)

The Catholic Central Alumni Scholarship — Awarded to two incoming freshmen who are sons, daughters, or grandchildren of Catholic Central or St. Mary High School alumni. (\$500 each)

Catholic Central's Scrip Tuition Reduction Program — Helps you earn money to put towards your child's tuition without spending any more than you already do (groceries, gas, clothing, home improvements, hotels, restaurants, etc.). Scrip means "substitute money," using gift cards from participating retailers at a discount.

Catholic Central Theater Association Scholarship — The Catholic Central Theater Association Scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman who has demonstrated a desire to pursue the Performing Arts at Catholic Central. This student should have experience with a production, either onstage or backstage. (\$250 value)

Edmund Impens Memorial Scholarship — Awarded to an incoming freshman who exhibits a passion for attending CCHS and has financial need. (\$1,000 value)

The Evan Buckhouse Memorial Scholarship — Awarded to two freshmen demonstrating scholastic potential, leadership experience, and personal character. (\$1,500 each)

Faith in Our Future Scholarship — Established by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee's Faith in Our Future Trust. This scholarship is awarded to two students per grade level and is renewable for up to four years.

Faith and Tradition Scholarship — For children of full-time faculty or staff members with at least four years of employment at one of our partner parish grade schools. Recipients are eligible to receive tuition aid for all four years.

Friends of Catholic Central — Created by anonymous donors to help families with tuition and transportation costs in order to attend Catholic Central High School.

The John and Katherine Pieters-Daniels Freshman Scholarship — Awarded to two freshmen in need of tuition assistance. Approximate value of \$5,000 each or 5% of the current market value of the restricted account, divided over four years.

K-12 Tuition Tax Deduction — State law allows Wisconsin parents to deduct private school tuition on their taxes. Parents statewide can deduct up to \$4,000 per student in grades K-8 and up to \$10,000 per high school student.



Financial Assistance Opportunities

Karen Wack-Zirbel Memorial Scholarship — Awarded to a student living in one of the following townships: Brighton, Bristol, Kansasville, Paris, Salem, Union Grove, or Wheatland, and who participates in extracurricular activities. (\$1,000 value)

The Lorraine M. & Robert C. Beix Memorial Scholarship — Awarded to two incoming freshmen who demonstrate exemplary scholastic ability, leadership, and personal character. (\$500 each)

The Mary Alice Yakich Education Foundation Scholarship — Awarded based on financial need, scholastic ability, and character. (*Value varies between \$500-\$3,500*)

The Need & Merit-Based Scholarship — Awards based on financial need and academic achievement. (\$2,000 value)

Normandie Byrne Tuition Scholarship — Awarded to a student belonging to St. Joseph's Parish in Lyons who demonstrates financial need. (\$1,000 value)

Partner Parish Discount — Families who are members of one of our 16 partner parishes receive a tuition discount from the school. Many parishes also offer additional financial assistance.

The Rewald Scholarship Trust — Created by Mr. Rewald, a local business owner, to help families with tuition costs to attend a private school. Families seeking tuition assistance are strongly encouraged to apply. (\$200,000 value overall)

The Robert Gorman & Leo Zinnen Scholarship — Awarded to applicants with an agricultural background within their immediate family, employment, or through activities such as 4-H. (\$1,000 value)

The Student Connector Scholarship — Awarded to an incoming Freshman who is interested in promoting a positive image of Catholic Central. *(approx. \$500 value)*

The Student Council Scholarship — Awarded to applicants demonstrating leadership skills, creativity, and originality. As a Council representative, recipients are expected to work collaboratively and represent classmates fairly. (\$300 value)

Troy Loos Memorial Scholarship — Awarded to an incoming freshman who demonstrates hard work, faith, strong academic standing, active involvement in sports, and dedication. (\$1,000 value)

Wisconsin School Choice Program — A statewide private school voucher program allowing students whose families meet certain income qualifications to attend participating private or religious schools tuition-free.

Additional Information

- 1. In Wisconsin, parents can claim a state income tax deduction for private high school tuition up to \$10,000. This is a tax deduction, which lowers your taxable income, rather than a tax credit, which would reduce your tax bill dollar-for-dollar.
- 2. Beyond CC scholarships, numerous outside organizations also offer scholarships. Families are encouraged to explore these opportunities directly, as eligibility and application deadlines vary.
