OUR HISTORY



1860

The story of Catholic Central High School began on December 7, 1860, when three courageous School Sisters of Notre Dame arrived in Burlington, Wisconsin, answering the call to educate students in the Catholic tradition at St. Mary's Parish. With faith as their compass and just two classrooms, they laid the foundation for generations of students to be formed in mind, body, and spirit. The first school building was located at the corner of McHenry and Jefferson Streets and had 110 students in two classrooms.



1919

By 1919, the growing parish of St. Mary's recognized the need for a Catholic high school. Despite strong opposition and limited resources, Fr. Van Treeck, pastor of St. Mary's, pursued the vision with steadfast determination.



1920

Amidst the Spanish Flu pandemic, Father Van Treeck and Sister Mary Michael, SSND, established St. Mary's High School as a two-year commercial course school in the original parish church that had been used as a meeting hall by the St. Eustachius Benevolent Society. With little more than faith and determination, Sister Mary Michael built an exemplary program that set the tone for decades to come



1925-1995

In 1925, the school celebrated its first graduating class, and by 1926, a new building was opened to meet increasing demand. There was a steady increase in enrollment from then on, peaking at more than 350 students in the late 1960's. In 1970 the high school built a new gym. In 1989, St. Mary's officially became Catholic Central High School, reflecting its expanded role as a regional high school supported by sixteen parishes across Racine, Kenosha, and Walworth counties. The early 1990's saw further transformation. The Marian Activity Center (MAC) was completed in 1993, and by 1995 a second floor expanded its academic and extracurricular facilities - now home to two gyms, Topper Hall Theater, classrooms, a library, and fitness center.



2020

In 2020, Catholic Central proudly celebrated its 100th anniversary, embracing both its legacy and its future. With state of the art technology, one-to-one iPads, and a modern college-preparatory curriculum, we continue to honor the vision of our founders. In 2021, Catholic Central formalized its affiliation with the School Sisters of Notre Dame, reaffirming our commitment to their mission of transformational Catholic education.

2025

Catholic Central High School proudly carries forward more than a century of faith-filled tradition while embracing a bold vision for the future. With new administrative leadership in place, we are invigorating our school culture and advancing plans to transform our facilities to meet the growing needs and interests of our students. Rooted in our Catholic mission and the legacy of the School Sisters of Notre Dame. Catholic Central continues to provide a Christ-centered, college-preparatory education that forms compassionate, confident leaders ready to serve the world.





- Register for our required placement assessment. This is a standardized admission test (the STS High School Placement Test, commonly referred to as the HSPT). Once the Placement Test is successfully completed, it will be evaluated by the Academic and Admissions Departments.
- Watch For Acceptance Notification
- Once a student has successfully completed the online application and Placement Test, students will receive notification of acceptance status in December-January. Accepted students will receive an invitation to attend freshmen registration in February.

At Catholic Central High School, we believe that a high-quality education should be accessible to all families. Our commitment to affordability ensures that your child can benefit from a private education without the financial strain. We offer significantly low tuition rates among the region, making us one of the most affordable private high schools in Southeastern Wisconsin. Through financial assistance, flexible payment plans, merit-based and need-based scholarships, our goal is to make our institution and educational programs accessible to as many students as possible.
